

# GDPR policy for the Swedish S-30 Association

## Parties and responsibility for the processing of your personal data

The Swedish S-30 Association processes personal data in accordance with Swedish law. When you have your personal data registered or otherwise processed, you have the right to information that we now provide to you.

The Swedish S-30 Association is responsible for the processing of personal data that you share with us when:

- you become a member or apply for membership
- you are a member.

## What personal data do we process about you?

Membership in the Swedish S-30 Association is voluntary and so is the provision of your personal information, but the Swedish S-30 Association needs certain personal information about you in order for you to be a member.

As a member, your personal information will be stored and processed for certain special purposes. The personal information we process about you is:

- Name
- Address
- Email adress
- Telephone number / mobile phone number
- VHF (if available)
- The name of the boat
- The boat's serial number

The personal data processing carried out in connection with your membership in the Swedish S-30 Association is legal because it is necessary for the fulfillment of the membership conditions and because the Swedish S-30 Association has a legitimate interest in being able to process the personal data for the purposes stated below.

## Why do we process your personal data?

The legal basis for the Swedish S-30 Association to collect and process personal data about you as a member is to be able to fulfill obligations towards you according to the membership statutes. It is needed for us to be able to identify you and administer your membership.

## **Who do we share personal information with?**

The Swedish S-30 Association does not share information with other organizations except: The printing company that prints our membership register.

## **The right to be forgotten**

The Swedish S-30 Association processes your personal data as long as you are a member with us. Membership information will be separated in connection with the termination of membership. When a member terminates his membership, information remains for a time but is hidden until it is finally deleted. The reason for retaining membership information may, for example, be that there are unpaid fees.

## **What rights do you have?**

You have the right to insight into how your personal data is processed. This means that you can request an extract from our registers about what information we have about you. You also have the right to request that incorrect personal information be changed.
